Sub : WRD- ISWC-Posting of supporting technical officers by party states to Cauvery Water Regulation Committee- Application called for-reg


As per the directions of Honourable Supreme Court of India, Government of India had constituted the Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) and Cauvery Water Regulation Committee (CWRC) for the implementation of Final Order of the Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal (CWDT) as modified by the Honourable Supreme Court of India.

The above committee consists of members from party states ie Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Union Territory of Puducherry and representatives from Ministry of Jal Shakti, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, GoI, Central Water Commission, India Meteorological Department(IMD) etc.

As there is an urgent requirement for appointment of supporting staff to enable the Authority as well as Committee to function effectively, the matter for posting of supporting technical officers (at the level of Executive Engineer and Assistant Engineer) from party states was discussed in the 3rd meeting of CWMA held on 28/05/2019. All the party states were requested to cooperate in the matter with regard to the posting of supporting technical staff (at the level of Assistant Engineer and Executive Engineer) to CWMA/CWRC.

The offices of the CWMA and CWRC are functioning at New Delhi. The office of CWRC will be shifted to Bengaluru after the completion of the renovation and interior furnishing works of the proposed office building. The nature of work includes coordination in collection and compilation of hydro-meteorological data from basin states, preparations for meetings of the CWMA/CWRC etc. The officials posted will be under the administrative control of Irrigation department, Government of Kerala.

In this connection, it is requested that officials under Irrigation department, in the rank of Executive Engineers and Assistant Engineers, who are interested to work with CWMA/CWRC may submit their willingness to this office, on or before 31st August 2019, for further necessary action.
