Kerala experiences two monsoon seasons, first from June to August and second from October to November. During 2018 and 2019, our state faced unexpected heavy flooding during monsoon season. In view of the above, Irrigation department has already been taken various additional measures to reduce the effect of flood, based on the direction from the Govt.

In continuation of the above actions, it is decided to take a close monitoring of the activities in connection with coming monsoon seasons. Hence the following additional responsibilities are assigned to the officers mentioned below, for the proper monitoring of the said activities.

Verifying reported water level in dams with respect to Rule Curve 5. Emergency Action Plan - Monitoring
2	Dy. Chief Engineer (I S W), O/o the CE (I S W)	1. Compilation of sea erosion details including geographical locations as per the Google sheet shared by KSDMA.
3	Dy. Chief Engineer (Vigilance), O/o the CE(I&A)	1. Monitoring of the operation of Thottappally Spillway in connection with the Flood control of Kuttanad area 2. Assessment of Water level of river draining in to in Kuttanadu area 3. Removal of sand bunds at Thottappally pozhy mouth
4	Executive Engineer (Irrigation Works) O/o the CE(I&A)	City Flooding in Thiruvananthapuram- Monitoring of the works carried out by Irrigation Department to prevent flooding
4	Executive Engineer (I S W) O/o the CE (I S W)	City Flooding in Kochi - Monitoring of the works carried out by Irrigation Department to prevent flooding
