1. Background

The Water Resources Department, Government of Kerala, is implementing activities under DLI-7 of the Resilient Kerala Program for Results (RKDP-II) supported by the World Bank. The programme envisages strengthening Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM) through river basin planning, hydrological and hydraulic modelling, flood forecasting systems, spatial database development, and decision support systems.

Government vide G.O.(Rt) No.214/2026/P&EA dated 22.05.2026 has accorded sanction for the engagement of two GIS Specialists and one Computer Programmer on contract basis for supporting ongoing DLI-7 activities and achieving programme targets within the stipulated timelines.

3. Collection, processing, analysis and validation of geospatial data from various sources.
4. Support for flood forecasting systems, river basin planning and GIS-based decision support systems.
5. Integration of GIS, remote sensing and field data for project activities.
6. Preparation of maps, reports and other technical outputs required for project monitoring and verification.
7. Providing technical support to departmental officers on GIS applications and spatial data management.
8. Carrying out any other GIS-related assignments entrusted in connection with DLI-7 activities.
